Also not forgetting the clean-up team Sunday morning. And a big thanks to Joy for her organisation





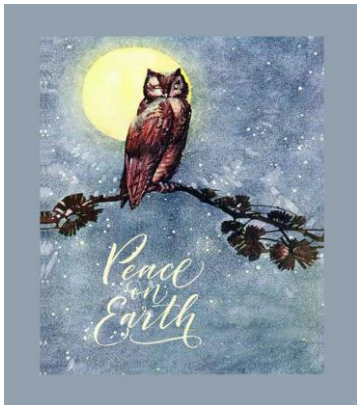
