Residents' Committee update

The House Manager, Peter Mellors, was invited to join the second half of the meeting. Here is a brief summary of business:

Coat hooks: The committee raised concerns about the removal of the coat hooks from the buggy room and these have been reinstated at no cost to the service charge fund.

Smart Meters: Many of us tried to get Smart Meters in the past and have been told they weren't available in this area because of signal issues. This situation has recently changed and they are now available. John Clarke tested this with EON and got one fitted in his bungalow in a couple of weeks. Others are following suit. The EON number to call to make an appointment is 0345 8623405 (Mon-Fri 9am-5pm).

If you're in an apartment, Mike Issott warns that you will have both a normal and an Economy 7 system. Residents who use both need to request a two-output rather than a single-output Smart Meter. John and Mike are both happy to advise anyone on how to go about it.

Lease information: Any apartment owners wishing to see a copy of their lease should contact Peter, the House Manager.

Trips out: There have been requests for more organised day trips, with a larger capacity, in addition to the lovely outings run by Joy in the Lions minibus. Peter has agreed to look into this with a view to organising monthly trips.

Daily Checks: Peter will make daily check calls to anyone would like them – very reassuring for anyone living alone. Please contact Peter to arrange.

Appello: There have been some issues since the transition of the Tunstall system to Appello. These have been escalated to senior McCarthy Stone management. Mike Issott will be asking some of the Brigg Court residents to make random calls to test the out-of-hours response. The damaged underground cable affecting bungalows 3, 4, 5 and 7 is due to be replaced.

Guest suite bookings: Peter has provided a final version of the guest suite procedure to all residents so please keep it handy in case you need to book it. The keys are in a key safe, accessed by the code given in the information sheet. The code is also on the notice on Peter's office door under his hours of work.
