In particular – parking, oiling hinges, cleaning cooker hood and much more. If you have any problems, please contact the house manager straightaway. If Peter can't resolve the problem he will report it on the McCarthy Stone system.

We have contacted Land Registry because of the delay in registering title deeds. There is a twelve month delay and some of the bungalows were only put on the Gov.uk Land Registry system in August 2021. If you used your own solicitor some of these appear on land registry database.
